New contacts continue to be made in Puthencruz. Pray for the visitation program. Due to the strong hold of the orthodox church in the lives of their church members in our town of Puthencruz, individuals have been restricted from having us enter their homes and hearing the salvation message. Although there is a resistance from the nominal church, God has been good to us and opened doors. Please pray for these individuals. They have received Christ as Saviour, but have not taken a decision in coming forward fully surrendering to Christ through baptism. We have invited them to attend Bible Studies, and church services. All the individuals understand the need for salvation because it is not taught in the church; however, they don't see the need to be baptized thereafter and live a separated life from their orthodox religion Please pray for these couples as we follow up and minister to them, Paul/ Mary and Jithu, Vijayan/ Lissy along with their children. Vinod/Lissy, and Paul. Praise the Lord for the confessions of faith and baptisms of Arun and his grandmother. Arun's parents were baptized several years before, for Revi and Kunjumol new believers in the Lord who were baptized along with Arun several weeks ago. In the midst of testings and shut doors, God is good by bringing the increase and encouraging our hearts to continue the work. Our God is big enough to open any door and strong enough to open the hardest heart.

Families are breaking apart all over the world. Satan weapons of warfare of disobedience, mistrust, rebellion are causing more and more families to become seekers of pleasure rather than seekers of God. Western culture has now becoming the world culture. We knew there was a need, all the tell tale signs pointed to it and by God's grace we were able to conduct it. *A one day family seminar was held in October*. 175 believers from various planted churches attended. We need \$60,000.* If the Lord is placing in your hearts a burden to give toward this need, please pray that the Lord will provide a way for you to give. We just don't have funds at the moment to use toward this project, and we are asking God's people to provide.

Please pray for the speakers as they begin to prepare their messages and that God will speak to the lost and open hearts of many to receive the Gospel.
